EXPERIENCE: the meaningfulmoment

POST EXPERIENCE: iterative considerations

ATTENTION: Drawing attention or awareness to the experience.

Schon: Reflection-in-action (thinking while doing) Boud: Returning to experience; Attend to feelings

Dewey: Content and process reflection

Mezirow: Thoughtful action/understanding

ANALYSIS: Drawing attention to the experience after it is over.

Kolb: Reflective observation

Boud: Re-evaluation of experience

Dewey: premise reflection and critical reflection

Mezirow: Reflection/critical reflection

EVALUATION/ACTION: Drawing attention to resolution or future action.

Kolb: Abstract conceptualizations

Boud: outcome resolution Kolb: Planning future action

Schon: Reflection-on action (thinking after acting)
