Methodology

- 50 Questions-
 - 10 demographic
 - Academic advising, Social connectedness/involvement
 - Faculty and staff approachability, Campus life
- 5 point Likert scale
- Online survey using Google forms
- Survey both Fall and Spring semesters google form analytics



Methodology

- Section 1
- Academic advising, scheduling, availability, making decisions to make progress on your degree. Advisor communication
- Section 2
- Social connections, Facebook, twitter, other media. Social events at Longwood, the nursing department
- Section 3
- Participation in clubs, activities, athletic events and organizations. The sense of belonging at Longwood and in the nursing department

Methodology

- Section 4
- The nursing faculty, feeling valued by the instructors and participating outside of class with instructors.
- Ability to participate in research with the faculty
- Presenting a global perspective
- Section 5
- Support services, financial aid, jobs placement, student health, facilities maintenance, registration process, safety on campus. Housing options and food services

- How satisfied are you with the assistance you received from your academic advisor?
- How satisfied are you with the types of social events offered at Longwood?
- How satisfied are you with your ability to connect and interact with other nursing students at Longwood?
- How satisfied are you with your plans to continue to attend this University next year?

Likert Scale


- Extremely satisfied

Question Analysis


- 41 respondents
- Demographics : Caucasian females, enrolled FT, average GPA 3.0-3.74
- Questions where more than 5% responded Slightly dissatisfied or Not at all satisfied
- Unexpected Findings: Advising was over all high on satisfaction but the amount of times met with instructor rated low on satisfaction
- Global perspective/study abroad, not satisfied with ability to participate in a study abroad.
- Ability to interact with faculty, research with faculty, and participate in nursing department activities important



How satisfied are you with the assistance you received from your academic advisor?




During this academic year, how satisfied are you with the number of times you have met with your academic advisor.

How satisfied are you with your ability to participate in a study abroad program at Longwood?




Extremely Satisfied-26.8%

Findings

- Small sample size, originally planned to place only in freshman year Spring semester
- Identified areas for further development
- Need to more narrowly define terms such as "extracurricular"
- Faculty should be broken down into major/minor faculty and faculty from other disciplines
- Identify focus for study abroad- 3rd world health and travel restrictions
