### Echo360

Facilitates rich media capture and delivery for courses. The software not only captures lectures but also allows for basic editing and media import. Requires an institutional licence. Longwood currently has a licence for Echo360.

### Lecture Tools

Lecture tools enables students to see and take notes on your slides, watch video lessons and access practice quizzes digitally. Longwood currently has a license for this software.

### Screencast-o-Matic

### ActiveInspire (Promethian)

The software allows the user of the interactive board access to tools and flipchart pages in order to make interactive digital lessons and presentations.

### Google Forms

### Learning Management Systems

LMS's such as Canvas and Blackboard are essential in delivering and storing content for students as well as creating web-based assessments. Additionally, content can be transferred from one course to the next.

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
