When a living person donates an organ or donates part of an organ for transplant into another person they are considered a living donor. (1)



## Can I be a living donor?

- Must be 18 years or older
- Have good mental and physical health
- Must be able to fully understand the risks involved with donation and be able to make your own decision about if living organ donation is the right decision for you (3)
