- 1. When I completed the Leadership-Potential Assessment, I realized that myself strong in the interpersonal skill section because I am able to understand, communicate and work well with individuals and groups through effective relationships.
- 2. I found myself as a leader role, performing management functions (planning, organizing, leading, and controlling) to effectively operate the managers unit to accomplish organizational objectives. Here at Longwood I am the President of the Club football team so i hold a lot of the leadership characteristics that are needed to plan, organize and lead the team. Those interpersonal skills are essential and help me be an effective leader on my team.
- 3. Although my score was not perfect the results from the assessment showed that I am an effective leader. My leadership style follows the liaison role because I understand how to interact with people outside of my organizational unit. I understand the importance of networking in order to develop and maintain relationships.
- 4. As a Social Worker, being a leader is important because they play huge roles in other people's lives. They have to act as advocates and role models in order to appropriately serve their clients. I feel that being a Social Worker interpersonal skills are very essential because we as Social Workers are constantly working to maintain relationships and connections with people in order to help the individuals and groups that need help.
