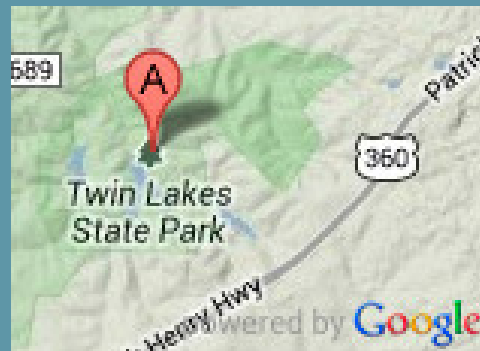

CAMPING

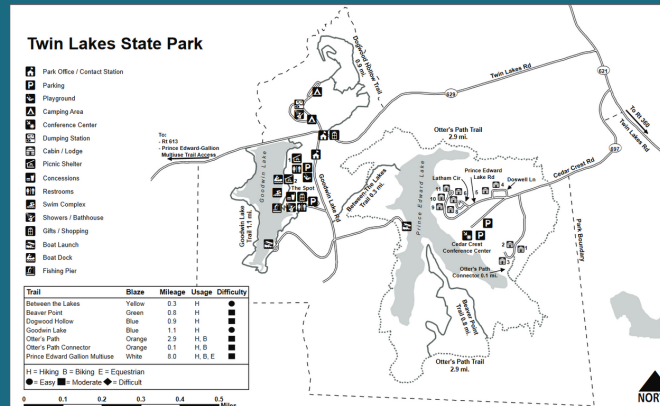
Accommodations include a 33-site campground and 11 climate-controlled cabins.

In Twin Lakes Park, there are 6 different trails that run miles through an 8-mile, non-loop multi-use trail in the adjacent Prince Edward-Gallion State Forest.
