Communication Sciences and Disorders (BS)

1. 5 out of 9 of the elective credits for the Neuroscience Studies minor are required for the BS degree in CSDS, including:
 - i. CSDS 455 – Neurology in Human Communication (3)
 - ii. CSDS 460 – Introduction to Neurogenic Communication Disorders (2)

2. The additional 4 elective credits can be chosen from any of the following:
 - i. BIOL 206 – Human Anatomy and Physiology (4)
 - ii. KINS 215 – Exercise is Medicine (3)
 - iii. MANG 362 – Organizational Behavior (3)
 - iv. PHIL 355 – Philosophy of Mind (3)

3. As a reminder, to fulfill the requirements for the minor, open electives must include:
 - i. PSYC 151 – Biopsychology or NEUR 105 - Introduction to Neuroscience
 - ii. NEUR 321 – Behavioral Neuroscience
 - iii. NEUR 405 – Interdisciplinary Neuroscience
