## Psychology (BS)

1. Take either or both of the following courses, one of which will fulfill the psychology major requirement for the “General/Experimental Area”:
  - i. PSYC 300 – Sensation & Perception (4)
  - ii. PSYC 324 – Learning (4)
2. The psychology major requires six psychology course electives in addition to classes from each area. Choose from:
  - i. PSYC 301 – Psychobiology of Stress (3)
  - ii. PSYC 452 – Psychopharmacology (3)
3. In the event that you do not wish to take either of the courses in part b, but instead choose to take alternate courses, consider taking any of the following courses to fulfill the 9 elective credits required for the Neuroscience Studies minor:
  - i. MANG 362 – Organizational Behavior (3)
  - ii. PHIL 355 – Philosophy of the Mind (3)
  - iii. KINS 215 – Exercise is Medecine (3)
  - iv. BIOL 206 – Human Anatomy and Physiology I (4)
4. As a reminder, to fulfill the requirements for the minor, open electives must include:
  - i. PSYC 151 – Biopsychology or NEUR 105 - Introduction to Neuroscience
  - ii. NEUR 405 – Interdisciplinary Neuroscience
  - iii. NEUR 151 – Biopsychology double counts for the Psychology major and the Neuroscience Studies minor
