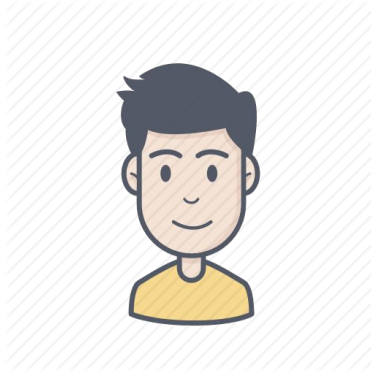

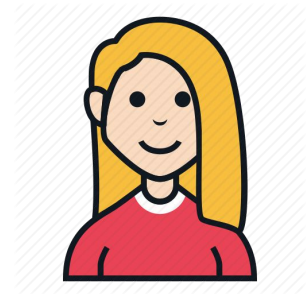

Centered Around:

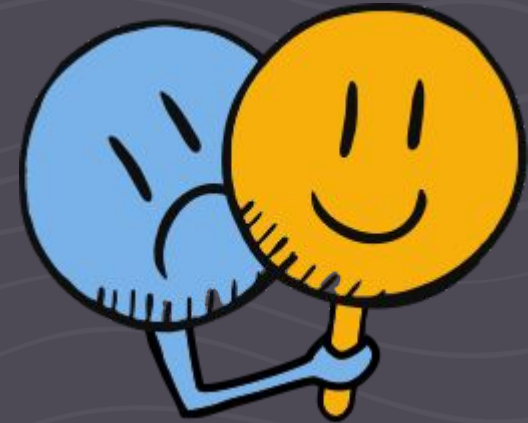
- learning interests/ how they prefer to learn

Centered Around:

- future career goals/
