There are many differences between contemporary conservatism and contemporary liberalism. Conservatives are very cautious towards change and sometimes do not support change at all and cling to age old, sometimes outdated, traditional values.

Contemporary Liberalism on the other hand is all for innovation and actively pursuing political change in our country, they fall into the Democratic party. They look to the government for help and think the government should be highly involved in solving problems. Tradition only holds our society back and prevents growth in their eyes. Liberalism also strongly advocates and supports minority groups. We see these ideals and views come out through the liberal view on abortion as well.
