

Results

The completion of the sugar tray activity was compared to how much time parents spent with their child/children, the time spent together was recorded on a 0-10 scale with 0 being not at all and 10 being very much. Completion levels were: attempted and completed, attempted but did not complete, and did not attempt. Findings indicate there there was a negative correlation ($r = -.180$) of parent involvement impacting the completion level of the activity. Simply, the children who fully completed the activity did not spend a lot of time with their parents. The researcher does not know if this would be true in a larger population.
