Military technology turned personal safety

RICHMOND, VA—A pristine military-grade safe was announced yesterday by security company SafeSafe.

Using military-grade nanobot technology, the SafeSafe Company has just released a new high-tech safe. The SafeSafe takes pictures of its surroundings and displays those images on its sides, resulting in a safe that blends seamlessly into whatever surrounding it is placed in.

In 2018, the FBI reported that there is a robbery every 1.6 minutes, and a burglary every 18.2 seconds, equating to 4,608 burglaries every day and an annual loss of \$14.3 billion.

Being that the average burglary takes 8-10 minutes, the testing stage allowed 30 different people 10 minutes to locate the safe in an average sized two-story house. Only one of them found it when he accidentally walked into it.

During the prototype stage, 10 of the 300 locations experienced a burglary, and the SafeSafe remained undetected in each case.

The design allows homeowners, business owners, or simply anyone who wants to protect their prized possessions to do so in plain sight. Burglars walk right past the SafeSafe, unaware that what they are after is right in front of them.

"Six months ago I was held at gunpoint and forced to hand over that week's earnings, which had been tucked away in a safe in my office" recalled Jerry Lipton, a small business owner. "My store struggled from the financial loss, but now SafeSafe keeps my mind at ease and provides my business a new level of security."
