You have requested for the potholes on your street to be filled prior to the start of the new year.

The recent rainy weather mixed with the freezing temperatures has caused more potholes each week. Potholes occur when rainwater freezes and expands in the cracks of the road. The water expanding causes the sub-layers of the road to be displaced and potholes are formed. Pothole repairs must occur when temperatures are above freezing for a period of at least a week to allow enough time for the material to cure. The weather forecast does not have temperatures being above freezing again until after the new year.
