The research question is "Do family fun time activities affect family involvement".

The survey question I am using to operationalize the dependent variable is "How much did the activity promote family involvement"? The attributes to this question includes a scale from 0-10, 0 being not at all, to 10 being a great amount. The question I am using for my independent variable is "What is your self-identified race"? The attributes for this question includes Native American or Alaskan Native, Asian, Black or African-American, Hispanic or Latino/Latina, White, Some other race and Prefer not to say. These questions are good for gathering research on family involvement because it provides a clear and precise question. Also these questions are also not double barrelled, and the questions are relevant to the research we are conducting in class. Lastly, the questions won't pose bias to the participants in the study. Once we have a list of questions, the structure of the questions will change, to ensure our demographic question is at the end of our survey.
