

*T-test for Race/Ethnicity*

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Race/Ethnicity	Means	T-statistic
White (Non-Hispanic)	8.6	5.326
Black or African American	10	

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Note:  $p < .05^*$ ,  $p < .01^{**}$ ,  $p < .001$

A T-test analysis of the variables race/ethnicity and level of involvement of the parents is shown in the table above. Of the chosen race/ethnicities, only White and African American were chosen. Data shows that there is a difference in means therefore we can reject the null hypothesis.
