What were the results of your Motive Profile (Self-Assessment 2-2)? How can understanding your motive profile be useful as a social worker?

How will you use this information moving forward as a social worker?

Conscientiousness personality traits include dependability and integrity. Highly dependable people tend to get the job done and are characterized as loyal, committed to their coworkers and their organization. Integrity is one of the core values for social workers in the code of ethics. Integrity is the foundation of trustworthiness. Integrity focuses on being honest, which includes no lying, cheating or manipulating, and stealing.

The surgency personality includes dominance, extraversion, and high energy with determination. In regards to dominance, successful leaders tend to assert themselves and want to be managers to take charge. Extroverts tend to score high in surgency because of their outgoing and outspoken personality.

Doing these assessments has really made me realize that I value the importance of integrity a lot more than I thought I have. I knew at the back of my mind that I really liked it when people are honest in situations, even when they are tough, but I did not realize how much I appreciated honesty from others.
