The dependent variable for this ANOVA was involvement of the parents. This was asked on a 0-10 scale. The independent variable for this ANOVA was educational attainment. Respondents were grouped into, “less than college”, “some college”, or “college or more”. The mean engagement for less than college was 6.71 out of 10 and some college was 7.34 out of 10. The mean engagement for college or more households was 6.75. According to the ANOVA results ( $F=0.05$ ) there is no significant difference between these means. Therefore, educational attainment does not influence family involvement.
