

What is systemic racism according to Dr. Bonilla-Silva? Give at least two examples from the video.

It's the Klan in the past. Systemic racism is ultimately reproduced by the actions and inactions of the green apples (Most Whites) (Non-White apples participate too mostly as they endure and fight racial domination. Systemic racism must be historically specific. Must have collective practices, behaviors, and culture that reproduce disadvantage for some and advantage for others at all levels. Materialist is systems that are in place. Systemic racism refers to societies where social, political, economic, cultural, and even psychological rewards are partially allocated by "race". Partially because the distribution of rewards in any society involves more than one axis of division – gender, class, and sexual orientation are, for instance, also important factors accounting for social stratification. Systemic racism is about collective practices and behaviors rather than a matter of a few racists. Examples in USA is slavery, genocide, land theft, and colonialism.

Why is "color-blind ideology" a form of racism?

Color-blind racism is when people state that they don't see color. It is anchored on the abstract extension of the principles of liberalism that furnishes apparently non-racial explanations for all sorts of race-related issues. The ideology is comprised of Frames, Style, and Racial stories. There
